Also as a Senior Fellow, Hedda speaks all over the country, presenting professional development for teachers and discussing Fred Rogers' work with audiences of all ages, helping them reflect on the timeless messages in Fred Rogers' beloved **Neighborhood** series – messages for adults as well as children.
